

## **QuickChange<sup>®</sup> Moveable Barrier System to Receive Prestigious Sperry Award**

*VACAVILLE, Calif.* – The prestigious Sperry Award will be presented to John Ward Duckett, founder and CEO of Barrier Systems, Inc during the development of the system at a meeting of the Society of Automotive Engineers on April 15, 2013.

This award annually recognizes distinguished engineering contributions that, through application proved in actual service, have advanced the state of the art of transportation whether by land, sea, air, or space. It honors Elmer A. Sperry, who was renowned for his navigational gyroscope and who coined the word automotive, giving SAE its name. This year it will be awarded for the development of the Quickchange Moveable Barrier System.

The Moveable Barrier System is manufactured and sold by Barrier Systems, Inc., a California based subsidiary of Lindsay Corporation headquartered in Omaha, Nebraska. It allows a concrete median barrier to be moved from lane to lane by a sophisticated

vehicle at up to 10 mph. It is used to increase safety in construction zones and to dramatically increase the efficiency of highways, bridges and tunnels by reconfiguring the roadway to utilize additional lanes in the congested direction.

Rick Parod, Chairman and CEO of Lindsay Corporation, was pleased to hear that John had been awarded this award and congratulated John and the team that helped develop this innovative product.
